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**Anthony J. Regan** has worked in Bougainville, Papua New Guinea, since 1981. He lived there from 1981 to 1991, 1994–97, and 2002–04. He was an adviser to all of the Bougainville parties in the Bougainville peace process and during the negotiation and implementation of the Bougainville Peace Agreement, signed in August 2001, including development of the constitution for the Autonomous Bougainville Government under the agreement. He was a full-time adviser during Uganda's postconflict constitution-making process for three years, 1991–94, where he advised the Ugandan government bodies responsible for the development of a new constitution. He continues to advise the Bougainville government on constitutional matters. He has also had limited involvement in either conflict resolution or postconflict constitutional development work in relation to Solomon Islands, Timor Leste, Sri Lanka, and Nagaland (India).

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
